Dear Horse Camper,

We are glad you will be in one of our week-long Horse Camps for the summer of 2011. We promise you a truly exciting week. **Please be sure to have your parent read this letter.** Please plan to check in at Heritage Lodge at Woodland Altars at **3:30** p.m. on Sunday. There will be **NO** check-ins before 3:30.

It is important that you **bring (do not send) the enclosed Health Information Sheet** on registration day. Please note that we cannot accept campers without a completed health information form. Also, it will be necessary for a parent, adult relative or adult familiar with the camper to accompany the camper to the nurse check-in. We will be asking questions regarding the most current status of the camper's health.

All horse campers will have an opportunity to participate in the **Riding Show** for parents on Saturday morning at the Six Pack Equestrian Center located at 803 Cemetery Road, a ten-minute drive from Woodland Altars. Parents are asked to pick up their camper where the camper has been staying at 9:30 a.m. and take them to the Equestrian Center for the horse show starting about 10:00 a.m. Please be prepared to spend about an hour in the outdoors. If you arrive late you can get to the Six Pack Equestrian Center by going **SOUTH** on Route 41 to the **CEMETERY**. Turn **RIGHT** onto Cemetery Rd. The Equestrian Center will be about 3 miles on your **LEFT**. It is very important that parents **SIGN THEIR CAMPER OUT WITH THE DEAN OF THE CAMP BEFORE LEAVING SIX PACK EQUESTRIAN CENTER.**

All horse camps participants are required to have shoes with heels no less than one-half inch and no more than two inches. Long pants are required for riding horses. Please bring a good attitude and a willingness to learn about safety as well as proper riding techniques.
