

SUMMER CAMP CHECKLIST
for Summer Camps at Woodland Altars sponsored by Outdoor Ministries.

PLEASE BRING THE CORRECT FORMS TO CAMP WITH YOU.

- ALL CAMPERS:** Health Information Form – must be signed by your parent or guardian.
- ALL CAMPERS:** Medications form – must be signed by your parent or guardian.
- Trip Permission Form – Eco-Adventures, Horse Camps, Youth Camp, Junior High Adventure – must be signed by your parent or guardian.
- Climbing Tower Release (For Junior High and Senior High camps)
- A Bible (A version YOU understand)
- Paper, pencils/pens
- Extra changes of socks and underwear (beyond the normal amount)
- Multi-weather clothing to last the length of your stay
- Raincoat or poncho
- Jacket or sweatshirt
- Towels and washcloth
- Shower shoes
- Swimsuit
- Soap, shampoo, deodorant, toothpaste, toothbrush, hairbrush, etc.
- Hat or cap and sunglasses
- Sun screen – we suggest 30+SPF
- Stationary and stamps in waterproof container
- Sturdy flashlight and extra batteries
- Non-aerosol insect repellent
- Pajamas

REQUIRED FOR ALL CAMPS

- Two pairs of **STURDY** shoes - (Sandals are permitted for POOL and shower use ONLY.)
- Bedding (Sleeping bag or blanket, sheets, pillow, etc.)
- Water bottle or canteen

REQUIRED FOR JUNIOR HIGH AND SENIOR HIGH AGE RIDGE CAMPS

- Plate, bowl, cup, silverware, and a dip bag (a webbed material bag for inserting washed dishes and silverware into boiling water for sterilization.)

REQUIRED FOR ALL RIDGE CAMPS

- Cot or Air Mattress

REQUIRED FOR ECO-CAMPS

- A sturdy day pack
- A **third** pair of shoes (old tennis shoes) for creek stomping (they will get wet and muddy)

REQUIRED FOR HORSE CAMPS & JUNIOR HIGH ADVENTURE

- Heavy jeans and boots or shoes with heel of at least ½ inch but no more than 2 inches (NO STEEL TOE BOOTS)
- Activity Release and Waiver for Six Pack Equestrian Center – must be signed by parent or guardian.
- OPTIONAL FOR HORSE CAMPS: Riding helmets will be provided, but you may bring your own if you prefer.

DO NOT BRING electronic devices such as cellular telephones, CD players, MP3 players, Game Boy, radios, snacks, or any kind of food.

Campers **will not** need spending money during camp. The camp store will be open during your registration and check-in period and at the conclusion of camp when your parents are with you.
